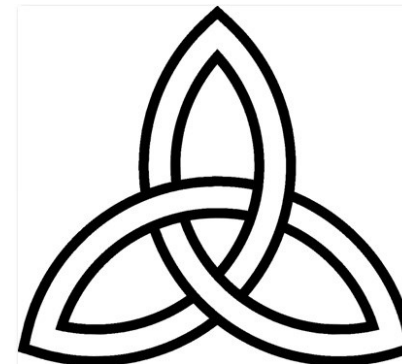

**The Annual Mass at Scalan** takes place on Sunday 2nd July at 4.00pm. Fr Michael Briody, President of the Scalan Association, has sent this information: "Scalan can be reached by leaving Tomintoul on the B9008. Just beyond Auchnarrow, about five miles later. Scalan is signposted on the right on an unclassified but good road. For those on satellite systems, AB37 9JS is a useful though approximate postcode. It should get you to Chapeltown of Glenlivet. The last mile and a half to Scalan, from Chapeltown is along a country track requiring sensible shoes, and one should be prepared for any weather. Cars and minibuses, but not coaches, can get very close to Scalan. Thankfully, like good Christians, those who take their cars along this track can be confidently waved down by those who would like a lift."
