Mass Bookings : Due to changes in COVID regulations, from Monday 9 August it will not be necessary to book Masses, although certain rules are still in place. These are as follows:

- **Track and Trace** will continue with Parishioners being marked in at the door.
- **Social Distancing:** Please note that the left hand pews facing the Altar are being reserved for Parishioners who wish to maintain social distancing.
- Parishioners will continue to be shown to their seats. Please make the stewards' job easier by following their seating instructions.
- We ask that Parishioners arrive at the Church at least 15 minutes before the beginning of Mass. This will allow the stewards to book Parishioners in, and show them to their seats before Mass starts.
- Face masks must still be worn, unless medically exempt. Public singing is allowed, but face masks must be worn.
- **As sanitisation is still of the utmost importance**, please continue to use the sanitiser when entering and leaving the Church.
- Children under the age of 12 are no longer required to wear face masks.

- Our church capacity is expanded to 200 people. If there are over 200 people at Mass we will have to apply the 'first come first served' rule.

Bulletins: From next week there will be our Bulletin printed for parishioners and put at the back of the Church. We ask Parishioners who take the printed copy of the Bulletin to take their bulletin with them when leaving the Church.
