

All Sunday Masses must still be booked. **Track and Trace:** All Parishioners attending Mass should email their names, addresses and telephone numbers to the bulletin email address: bulletin@sbek.org. This is a requirement of the Scottish Government as laid out in the Guidelines. **With the number of attendees at Masses having been increased, in order to save congestion at the door when booking in, we ask that Parishioners come at least 15 before Mass starts.**
