Ukrainian Appeal: It has become necessary to conclude this chapter of the Ukraine appeal as Father Rafal will go on his sabbatical 1 September 2022. Until then we will continue to receive donations which can be brought to the Church Hall each Friday from 12 August 2022 until Friday 26 August 2022 between the hours of 11.00 am and 4.00 pm. St Bride's Ukraine Support Team will pack the donations, and Father Rafal will arrange them to be transported to Poland at the end of August, similarly to previous lorries of humanitarian aid.

Fr Francis McGachey has been appointed to the parish, and he will decide if he wants to continue the Ukraine appeal or not. All the storage facilities, volunteers, contacts and everything is ready for the appeal to be easily continued as long as there is need for it. That should not require a big effort or input from the new priest as all our volunteers/parishioners are well trained by now.

The possible moving of the **church organ** will be discussed and decided at the open meeting on **Sunday 21 August at 3.00 pm**.
