

**Ukraine Appeal:** We are happy to say that our second lorry left on Thursday 24 March and safely reached its destination in Caritas Siedlce on Tuesday 29 March. Pictures can be seen on the Parish Facebook and Twitter. Big 'thank you' goes to Colin Lawson from Aberdeen for providing us his lorry and driver Chris free of charge. We plan to continue the appeal as the war conflict does not seem to end soon. We plan to send our third lorry after Easter. We will resume accepting donations after Easter. If you wish to help with sorting and packing the donations, please contact us on 07932 039810. Fr Rafal thanks you all for any contribution towards this appeal. All updates are posted on our parish social medias. As of Wednesday 23 March there were 2.25 million Ukrainian war refugees in Poland, of which nearly two thousand were taken straight to hospitals. Of this two thousand, just over 1.000 were children. Part of our second lorry shipment was delivered by Caritas Siedlce to Lutsk on Wednesday 30 March. Those donated gifts were delivered to a hospital and to Kharkiv in Eastern Ukraine. Caritas Siedlce supports both Ukrainian war refugees who came to Poland, and people who stayed in Ukraine. Please remember the people of Ukraine in your prayers, especially those being starved to death in Marioupol, those being deported to Russia, and those who pass away.

**COVID Update Procedures:** With COVID number on the rise, and in accordance with the requests of a large number of Parishioners, please see below:

- We will continue sanitising pews and kneelers at the Vigil and Sunday Masses. This will help to alleviate Parishioners' concerns.

- The Sign of Peace: Shaking hands will be purely voluntary and a personal decision to be made by each Parishioner.
- The wearing of face masks will continue.
- We will continue with a 1 metre distancing policy.

This is suitable for all Primary School age children. We will need 13 children to enact the Passion, chosen on the day. We have costumes to wear, so turn up a little early for a part. There will then be Veneration of the Cross and Communion and we will then look after the children in the Hall until the church service is complete. More details next week.
