

The Silver Jubilee of Ordination to the Priesthood of Fr Romanus Enyinnia, Administrator of St Vincent de Paul's, East Kilbride, will be celebrated this year. The Mass of Thanksgiving to celebrate Fr Romanus' 25th Anniversary will be the Vigil Mass on Saturday 6 August at 6.00 pm. Fr Romanus is from the Diocese of Ahiara in Nigeria, and has been ministering here in Scotland for the last six years. Our prayers are with him as he thanks God for his years as a priest.

Ukrainian Appeal: As our Parishioners are aware, Father Rafal has been instrumental and pivotal in advancing the needs of the Ukrainian people; not only within East Kilbride, but also in the wider Scottish Community. The family of St Bride's Parish, together with others from nearby communities, have continued to support Father Rafal's efforts to support the people of Ukraine. It has however become necessary to conclude this chapter of the Ukraine appeal as Father Rafal will go on his sabbatical 1 September 2022. Until then we will continue to receive donations which can be brought to the Church Hall each Friday from 12 August 2022 until Friday 26 August 2022 between the hours of 11.00 am and 4.00 pm. St Bride's Ukraine Support Team will pack the donations, and Father Rafal will arrange them to be transported to Poland at the end of August, similarly to previous lorries of humanitarian aid.

A new priest will be appointed to the parish, and it will be up to him to decide if he wants to continue the Ukraine appeal or not. All the storage facilities, volunteers, contacts and everything is ready for the appeal to be easily continued as long as there is need for it. That should not require a big effort or input from the new priest as all our volunteers/parishioners are well trained by now.

Historically, **the church organ** was located at the back of the church. We are planning to move the organ from the Sanctuary to the back of the church to improve the singing in our church, and hopefully to build up our music and choirs. If you have some serious objections, please speak to Fr Rafal.
