THE EASTER VIGIL

The Easter Vigil is in Four Parts

As the Paschal Candle is placed in the sanctuary, the following is sung three times: *Lumen Christi*. We answer: *Deo Gratias*. The Candle is placed high on the sanctuary and the joyful song of the Easter Proclamation (Exultet) is sung, as we rejoice in all that this light symbolises for us and for our world in the new life of Christ.

PART TWO: THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

The story of our salvation is told once more. We relive the story. As we listen to the Old Testament narrative our trust in the promise of redemption and hope for men and women is rekindled.

PART THREE: THE LITURGY OF BAPTISM

Through our baptism we share in the risen life of Christ and are called to share in his work of redeeming the world. Tonight we recall our own baptism, renewing our personal baptismal promises and reflecting on their significance for us.
