

PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO ROME IN OCTOBER

This year is the Jubilee Holy Year in Rome: it began on Christmas Day last year and ends on the Feast of the Epiphany next year. Jubilee years are celebrated every twenty-five years. While in Rome it is customary to visit the four Papal Basilicas and pass through their Holy Doors in each with a view to receiving the Jubilee Indulgence.

We plan on taking a group from Saint Bride's Parish, from 6th - 10th October, 4 nights, five days. So far around twenty parishioners have signed up.

Flights are with Jet2 leaving from Glasgow. We will be staying at the Casa Santa Lucia in Rome on a bed and breakfast basis. Depending on the number of people who are going, the approximate cost is £1,000 per person. The price includes luxury coaches, both here and in Rome, with full spiritual programme, attendance at the Papal Audience, and visits to the Four Principal Papal Basilicas, Mass in the Vatican and much more. CHILDREN'S LITURGY

We will start back again on 23rd February with the first week of our programme of preparation for First Communion for children attending St Hilary's and St Kenneth's schools. This will take place in the Parish Hall with an early start of 9:15am, while normal Children's Liturgy will start at 9:30am in the back room of the Parish Hall.



ASH WEDNESDAY - 5th MARCH 2025

Ash Wednesday starts the Season Lent, and this year falls on the 5th March. Ashes will be blessed and distributed at the following times: 7am, 10am, 2pm (in Saint Kenneth's Primary School) and 7pm.

Stations of the Cross will take place at 9.30am on Ash Wednesday.

It is likely that Saint Andrew's and Saint Bride's High School will have several Masses in the afternoon. Father Martin will also distribute Ashes in Hairmyres Hospital. More details, including the full Lenten programme, will follow.
