BISHOP TOAL'S CHRISTMAS MESSAGE 2015

In proclaiming the Jubilee Year of Mercy Pope Francis encourages us "to contemplate the mystery of mercy, the wellspring of joy, serenity and peace".

The mercy of the Father is revealed to us in a definitive way when, in the fullness of time God sent his Son into the world, born of the Virgin Mary. Our contemplation of mercy then begins as we look upon and cherish the gift of the Christ Child in the manger each Christmas. We experience in the depths of our hearts what Jesus promised, "whoever sees me sees the Father" (Cf. In 14:9). Then along with the Holy Father we renew our faith that "Jesus of Nazareth, by his words, his actions, and his entire person reveals the mercy of God" (Misericordiae Vultus, 1).

In Zechariah's beautiful canticle, the *Benedictus* in St Luke's Gospel, we hear, and perhaps recite daily, the words "to give his people knowledge of salvation through forgiveness of their sins, this by the tender mercy of our God, who from on high will bring the rising Sun to visit us". The Child Jesus is indeed the rising Sun coming to visit us and save us from our sins, and we rejoice in the tender mercy of our God. May our contemplation and celebration of his birth in Bethlehem bring consolation and healing to our own lives and to all who need to know and experience the Father's mercy. May the Year of Mercy be a fruitful time for the whole Church, and inspire us to be tender and truly merciful like Our Father.

I pray for the Lord's blessing upon your families, parishes and communities this Christmas, and pray that all who are troubled or live in trying circumstances or places may know his peace. + *Joseph Toal*
