than we dare presume.

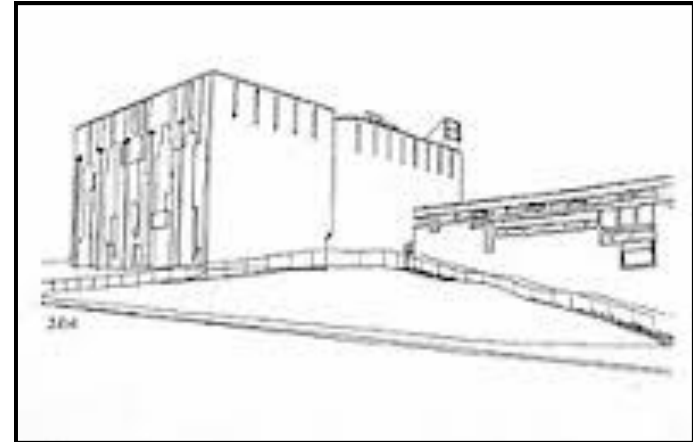
We thank you for this presence,
